**2018 GRADUATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**


Students must earn a min. of 80 credits and write provincial assessments of numeracy and literacy. The 80 credits include 52 credits for required courses (including 8 credits of Career Education courses) and a min. of 28 elective credits. Students must complete a min. of 16 credits at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12 and Career Life Connections.

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
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
